for help?



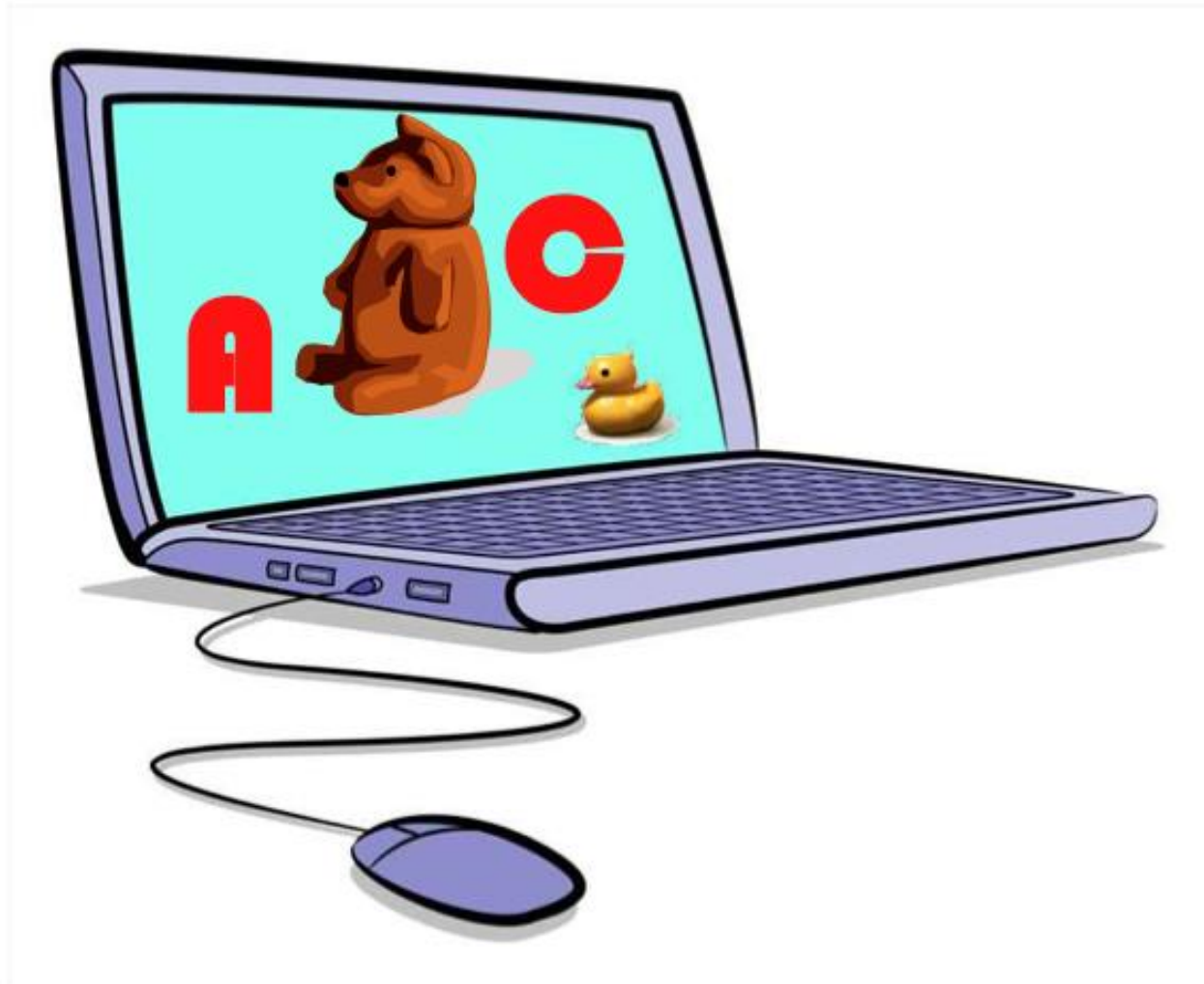

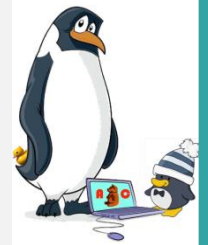
What did we learn from Smartie the Penguin?
